

General Rules:

- 1. <u>All entries are due July 28, NO EXCEPTIONS</u>. They must be postmarked July 24 or hand delivered to the Fair office on or before 5:00 pm Friday July 28.
- 2. Exhibitors will have TWO (2) MINUTE CALL BEFORE SHOW IS CLOSED WITH NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- 3. All species and showmanship classes are open to youth (21 years and younger as of Jan. 1).
- 4. All animals entered must be owned by the exhibitor but may be shown by family or friends where circumstances deem necessary (i.e. two animals of exhibitor in same market or quality class).
- 5. All entry fees plus added money and donations MINUS 10% judges fee through the Jerome County Fair will be paid out to exhibitors. Payouts will be paid to <u>at least</u> 3rd place but with the possibility (based upon donations) of paying down further. All payouts will be given in the show ring, and 24 hours after show. If not picked up in that time frame it will be put back to Fair.
- 6. Bedding is not provided by the Jerome County Fair and must be removed by exhibitor at the end of Fair Week. ALL PENS MUST BE LEFT CLEAN PER SUPERINTENDENT OR A \$25 PER PEN FINE WILL BE GIVEN.
- 7. Jerome County 4-H and FFA exhibitors may use their weights from the 4-H and FFA shows and will be added to entry form at check-in.
- 8. Outside exhibitors still must meet the entry deadline, your weigh-in time is posted below and weight will be added to your entry at that time.
- 9. If the entries are not completed, including contact numbers, entry fees, and all asked for information your entry WILL NOT be accepted.
- 10. Classes will be posted in order of judging at the rings.
- 11. All exhibitors MUST check in at the secretary's table and pick up their number. That number must be on exhibitor's left arm while showing.

General Rules for Showmanship Jackpot - All Species:

- 1. Entry fee is \$5 per exhibitor.
- 2. All entry fees will be paid to the Champion in each age division.
- 3. All Pee Wee entries will receive a blue ribbon.
- 4. Exhibitor must show their own animal and the animal must be entered in their respective quality or market class to be used as a showmanship animal, with the exception of the Pee Wee division.
- 5. Participant age will be determined as of January 1 of current year.
- 6. Classes will be broken by age, as follows:

a. **Pee Wee** 7 years old and younger

b. Junior 8-11 years old
c. Intermediate 12-15 years old
d. Senior 16-21 years old

1. Showmanship ~Pee Wee Class to Senior Class.

2. Quality:

a. Open to all general breeds.

- b. Each breed will have separate classes based on age of animal. If there are insufficient numbers of one breed to fill a class, they will be lumped together with another breed of same age class to show, yet will be judged separately.
- c. Classes as follows:
 - I. Heifer, Junior Calf: Born on or after January 1st of current year.
 - II. Heifer, Senior Calf: 7-12 months of age.
 - III. Heifer, Junior Yearling: 13-17 months of age.
 - IV. *Heifer, Senior Yearling*: 18-23 months of age.
 - V. Cow: 2-3 years of age.
 - VI. Cow: 4 years of age or older.

Note: All heifer class champions will compete for Junior Champion. All cow class champions will compete for Senior Champion. Jr. and Sr. Champions will compete for Overall Quality Champion.

Rules and Guidelines

- A. All General & Animal rules apply.
- B. Only minor trimming, washing, grooming, and fitting as necessary for the day of the show appearance.
- C. Dairy goats are the only breed required to be in milk if over 2 years.
- D. Animals entered in the market classes must be weighed before show start .
- E. Meat goat entering market class must have kid teeth in normal positions at time of final weigh in; any wether having lost any kid teeth will be disqualified.
- F. Animals will be judged by the following criteria to their species: Muscling--Growth and Frame-Structure & Soundness—and
- G. if applicable Dairy Character and Mammary System
- H. There will be no pre-show milk out. Over distended udders will be discriminated against.

1. Showmanship ~Peewee Class to Senior Class

The best two showmen from each age class, except for peewee, will move up to compete for the overall Grand Champion showman.

Goat Quality classes will be shown separately, and at the conclusion of the show the Overall Grand and Reserve Champions will be chosen by which animal displays the best to its breed description.

 - c. Champions of each breed will compete for Overall Quality Champion.
 - d. Classes as follows:
 - I. Heifer, Junior Calf: Born on or after January 1 of current year.
 - II. Heifer, Senior Calf: 7-11 months of age.
 - III. Heifer, Junior Yearling: 12-17 months of age.
 - IV. *Heifer, Senior Yearling*: 18-23 months of age.

V. Cow: 2 years or older.

VI. *Cow/Calf Pair:* 2 years or older VII. *Bull, Junior Calf:* Born on or after January 1 of current year.

VI. Bull, Senior Calf: 7-12 months of age.

 - a. Classes will be broken by weight into manageable size; no weight limits.
 - b. Weigh in will be from 7:30-8:30 AM.

Entry Fee: \$3 per Bird. Guidelines and rules

- A. Poultry must be owned by exhibitor and entered in proper classes.
- B. Study your breed, the judge will ask questions.
- C. No for sale signs allowed on cages at any time.
- D. Exhibitors wishing to sell birds are responsible for their own sales. No sales will be handled by Fair personnel.
- E. Exhibits are entered and shown at the owners risk.
